Discover Battambang's Bamboo Train, traditional villages, and Phnom Sampeau's bats at dusk. Stay at the Smiling Gecko Farmhouse and learn about sugar palm cultivation. Experience Phnom Penh's Royal Palace, street food, and architectural treasures. Conclude with an immersive adventure in the Cardamom Mountains, followed by coastal discoveries and sunset cruises in Kep. This tour blends iconic highlights with hidden cultural gems.

## Itinerary Details

### **Day 1: Siem Reap Arrival**

Welcome to Siem Reap. Upon arrival, meet your local tour guide and transfer comfortably to your hotel. Settle in and unwind, taking in the charm of the city as you prepare for your adventure. Enjoy your first evening at leisure.

Overnight in Sala Lodge (5 Star) or similar.

### **Day 2: Angkor Hidden Temples & Sunset Cocktail Experience (B)**

Explore Angkor's hidden gems by Remork. Begin at Srah Srang royal pool before visiting the jungle-clad Ta Prohm temple. Walk onward to the peaceful Ta Nei and discover Ta Keo. Climb to the Victory Gate of Angkor Thom and explore Vihear Prampeilveng. Continue through Preah Palilay, the Elephant Terrace, Terrace of the Leper King, Phimeanakas, and Baphuon. Conclude at Bayon, famed for its giant stone faces. End the day with a Sunset Cocktail at a Khmer Wooden House overlooking Srah Srang.

Overnight in Sala Lodge (5 Star) or similar.

### **Day 3: Sunrise Balloon Ride & Angkor Grand Circuit Discovery (B)**

Begin the day with a sunrise hot air balloon ride over the plains of Siem Reap. Return for breakfast before exploring Angkor Wat, climbing its stone staircases for panoramic jungle views. Participate in a traditional monk blessing ceremony for spiritual serenity. In the afternoon, visit Banteay Srei, Banteay Samre, Eastern Mebon, Pre Rup, and continue along the Grand Circuit to uncover Cambodia's rich heritage.

Overnight in Sala Lodge (5 Star) or similar.

### **Day 4: Private Tonle Sap Luxury Lake Cruise (B/ L)**

Cruise the Great Tonle Sap Lake aboard a private wooden yacht. Relax on plush cushions while enjoying champagne or cocktails and signature canapés. Admire floating villages and the rhythm of daily life on the water. Choose between a Khmer or Western lunch freshly prepared on board as you soak in the vibrant surroundings.

Overnight in Sala Lodge (5 Star) or similar.

### **Day 5: Scenic Journey to Battambang & Bamboo Train Experience (B)**

Travel overland to Battambang, passing scenic rice paddies and orchards. After lunch, experience the unique Bamboo Train ride through the countryside. Explore Battambang's French colonial streets and local art galleries, and stop at Kinyei Café to discover the town's coffee culture.

Overnight in Maison Wat Kor (4 Star) or similar.

### **Day 6: Battambang Village Life & Phnom Sampeau Sunset (B/ L)**

Tour local villages by Remork, meeting families who produce rice paper, dried bananas, and bamboo sticky rice. Sample freshly made treats and enjoy seasonal fruits with coconut water at a traditional Khmer house. Visit a Khmer Rouge memorial and Wat Ek Phnom. In the afternoon, explore Phnom Sampeau, the Killing Cave, and witness thousands of bats streaming into the sky at dusk.

Overnight in Maison Wat Kor (4 Star) or similar.

Validity Period: Oct 2025 to Sep 2026

**Day 7: Kampong Chhnang Pottery & Arrival at Smiling Gecko Farmhouse (B)**

Transfer toward Phnom Penh with a stop in Kampong Chhnang to visit a family-run pottery workshop. Continue to Smiling Gecko Farmhouse for an overnight stay surrounded by paddy fields and jungle. Explore the campus and learn about the community development initiatives.

Overnight in Smiling Gecko Farm-House () or similar.

**Day 8: Sugar Palm Village Experience & Countryside Leisure (B)**

Join a half-day Sugar Palm Tour in Domnak Ompel Village. Learn how locals harvest sap, produce palm sugar, and sample fresh palm juice or traditional palm wine. Spend the afternoon at leisure, relaxing in the peaceful rural surroundings.

Overnight in Smiling Gecko Farm-House () or similar.

**Day 9: Transfer to Phnom Penh (B)**

Enjoy a leisurely morning at Smiling Gecko Farmhouse before transferring to Phnom Penh. Admire the changing landscapes as you journey to the capital and check in at your hotel.

Overnight in Rosewood Phnom Penh (5 Star) or similar.

**Day 10: Phnom Penh Heritage by Cyclo & Ultimate Street Food Experience (B/ D)**

Explore central Phnom Penh by cyclo accompanied by a young architect, discovering colonial and historic landmarks. Visit the Royal Palace and Silver Pagoda to admire Khmer opulence. In the evening, join an Ultimate Street Food Tour sampling over 20 local dishes, ending with a cocktail in the city's lively nightlife scene.

Overnight in Rosewood Phnom Penh (5 Star) or similar.

**Day 11: Into the Cardamom Wilderness (B/ D)**

Travel to Botum Sakor National Park and arrive at Cardamom Tented Camp. Enjoy a boat ride along the Preak Tachan River before settling into your tent. Optional activities include jungle hikes, river swims, kayaking, or zip-lining. Dine riverside as the sun sets over the Cardamom Mountains.

Overnight in Cardamom Tented Camp or similar.

**Day 12: Cardamom Mountains Trekking & Wildlife Adventure (B/ L/ D)**

Embark on trekking and kayaking adventures through the Cardamom Mountains. Visit the old ranger station and explore jungle trails before returning for lunch. In the afternoon, enjoy zip-lining, river swimming, or wildlife spotting, including Pileated Gibbons and Smooth-Coated Otters.

Overnight in Cardamom Tented Camp or similar.

**Day 13: Jungle Exploration & Riverside Relaxation (B/ D)**

Trek deeper into a remote section of the forest before returning for lunch at camp. Tailor your afternoon with kayaking, hiking, or river swimming. Relax amid the sounds of the jungle and enjoy dinner under the stars.

### **Day 14: To Kep via Kampot & Private Champagne Sunset Cruise (B)**

After breakfast, enjoy a swim or kayaking before returning by boat to Trapeang Rung. Transfer to Kep with a stop in Kampot to stroll the local market and admire French colonial architecture. Upon arrival, check in and later enjoy a private Champagne Sunset Cruise with canapés.

Overnight in Knai Bang Chatt (4.5 Star) or similar.

### **Day 15: Kep Coastal Heritage & Local Life Discovery (B)**

Explore Kep by local Tuk Tuk. Visit abandoned colonial villas, the Siren of the Sea statue, Crab Market, Giant Crab statue, and the King's Mother's house. Pause by the sea for drinks and tropical fruits while learning about local salt fields, fish sauce production, bird's nest houses, and rice paddies.

Overnight in Knai Bang Chatt (4.5 Star) or similar.

### **Day 16: Kep Leisure by the Sea (B)**

Enjoy a full day at leisure to relax by the coast, explore the serene surroundings, or indulge in local delicacies.

Overnight in Knai Bang Chatt (4.5 Star) or similar.

### **Day 17: Kep Leisure by the Sea (B)**

Another day at leisure to unwind at your own pace and savour the tranquil seaside atmosphere.

Overnight in Knai Bang Chatt (4.5 Star) or similar.

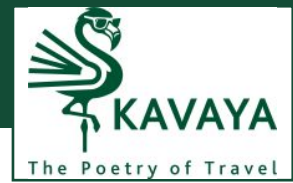
### **Day 18: Kep Departure (B)**
