

## Temples of Angkor

4 Days / 3 Nights

Before dawn, travel to Angkor Wat and explore the grounds by torchlight before watching the sun rise over Angkor Wat's famous spires. Journey through the Cambodian countryside before entering Angkor Thom where you will gain your first view of the many faces of Bayon temple. Afterward, visit the local Dom Deak market to experience daily life, and conclude your day at the Cambodian Landmine Museum, gaining insight into the country's history and ongoing efforts for recovery. This journey offers a blend of historical exploration, cultural immersion, and educational experiences, providing a rich understanding of Cambodia's heritage.



### Insider Experiences

- Explore the enigmatic Bayon Temple with its hundreds of massive stone faces, a highlight of the ancient city of Angkor Thom.
- Witness the sunrise over the iconic Angkor Wat, a breathtaking experience that reveals the temple's grandeur in the soft morning light.
- Discover the atmospheric Ta Prohm temple, where ancient trees and roots weave through the ruins, offering a perfect blend of nature and history.
- Cruise through the flooded mangrove forests of Kampong Pluk floating village, experiencing the unique lifestyle of a community living above water.
- Participate in a traditional monk blessing ceremony at an active pagoda, receiving holy water and well wishes through ancient chants.

## Itinerary Details

### **Day 1: Siem Reap Arrival**

Welcome to Siem Reap – your gateway to the awe-inspiring temples of Angkor and the rich heritage of Cambodia! Upon arrival, enjoy a smooth transfer to your hotel where a refreshing welcome drink awaits. The rest of the day is yours to unwind, explore the local atmosphere, or simply relax as anticipation builds for the incredible journey ahead through ancient wonders and cultural treasures.

### **Day 2: Siem Reap (B)**

After breakfast start your Angkor exploration tour to the Southern Gate of Angkor Thom, the 'Great City'. Today you will visit many of the finest temples of King Jayavarman VII, who ruled from 1181 to 1220. At the Southern gate of Angkor Thom, you will marvel at the imposing 23m (75-foot) high stone faces of Avalokiteshvara, featured in the Tomb Raider movie. These astonishing carvings inspire awe and wonder in all who view them. At the center of this citadel lies the state temple Bayon, which we will also visit. This temple-mountain, built at the end of the 12th century, is adorned with hundreds of gigantic stone faces. The tour also includes the Terrace of the Elephants and the Terrace of the Leper King.

Later in the day you will discover the most famous temples from the 11th century: Baphuon and Phimeanakas. Then visit Ta Prohm. The temple is famous for its massive trees with thick roots, which entangle the walls. They were left here intentionally by the archeologists working on the site. While clearing back the forest it was decided to leave them in place to serve as a reminder of how the original discoverers found the temples. Many of the trees have grown around and through the remains, and soar high above the temple. At the end of the day, we explore the magnificent Angkor Wat, built under Suryavarman II. Return to Siem Reap. Conclude the day with a foodie tour to taste real Cambodian Street Food. You will be picked up by Remork (Tuk Tuk) to enjoy the real Khmer night life. A long road lined with mats for hire, with dozens of street food sellers invites to join the locals for a beer. You also can taste various snacks here. Your tour guide will accompany you and explain about the food. (2 people per Remork)

### **Day 3: Siem Reap (B/ D)**

Don't forget to set your alarm, as today we start at pre-dawn to witness the breathtaking sunrise over Angkor Wat. Breakfast is served at a local restaurant near the temple complex. Afterwards the tour continues to the beautiful sandstone temple of Banteay Srei. The temple dates back to 967 AD, and is dedicated to the Hindu god Shiva. Banteay Srei is famous for the intricate friezes carved into its red sandstone walls. In the afternoon visit Kampong Pluk floating village. This is an isolated community of three villages built on stilts. These scenic villages are flooded for around half the year (Aug/Sept - Feb), enabling row boat journeys that provide income for the local community. You will take the small boat through the flooded mangrove forests; this unique ecosystem survives on wet soil for half the year, fostering a variety of wildlife. Back on "dry land" experience an original monk blessing ceremony in an active pagoda. The monk will sprinkle holy water while chanting sacred Pali canons to wish good luck and health for everyone. Return to Siem Reap. In the evening enjoy a sumptuous Khmer Farewell Dinner in a beautiful local restaurant.

### **1. Booking & Confirmation**

All services are subject to availability and confirmed in writing. Proposals are valid at the time of issue and will only be guaranteed once accepted within a reasonable period. Rates may change if acceptance is delayed.

### **2. Payment Conditions**

Full payment is required before guest arrival:

- Vietnam, Cambodia, Laos, Myanmar, Thailand, Indonesia: **30 days prior**
- Japan, South Korea, Singapore, Malaysia, Philippines: **35 days prior**

Payments must be made to the bank account stated on the invoice. All bank charges are borne by the payer. Late payments may result in price increases or cancellation of services. Overdue balances of more than 30 days are subject to 4% annual interest.

### **3. Deposits & Tickets**

Most FIT bookings do not require deposits unless specific suppliers (e.g., cruises, trains, hotels) request it.

**Group bookings for Japan & South Korea:** 15% refundable deposit.

Airlines may impose immediate issuance and non-refundable conditions; once tickets are issued, airline cancellation rules prevail.

### **4. Cancellation Policy**

Cancellations must be submitted in writing.
