Experience the very best of Vietnam on this immersive 11 day journey from north to south. Begin in Hanoi with visits to the Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum, Temple of Literature and a hands on cooking class, then seek serenity at Yen Tu Mountain and cruise among the limestone karsts of Halong Bay. Discover imperial Hue and the Perfume River, wander the lantern lit streets of Hoi An via Hai Van Pass, unwind on the beaches of Nha Trang with island excursions to Hon Mun, and conclude in dynamic Ho Chi Minh City exploring Notre Dame Cathedral, Ben Thanh Market and historic landmarks.

- Private early morning access to Hanoi's Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum complex and Temple of Literature, gaining deeper insight into - Vietnam's revolutionary history and scholarly traditions
- Sunrise cable car ascent to Yen Tu Mountain with time for quiet reflection at Truc Lam Zen Monastery and Dong Pagoda above the clouds
- Overnight luxury cruise in Halong Bay with Tai Chi at dawn and immersive exploration of limestone caves and hidden lagoons
- Hands on Vietnamese cooking class in Hanoi, from market style ingredient selection to preparing and enjoying your own traditional dinner
- Cycling or walking through Tra Que Vegetable Village in Hoi An, meeting local farmers and discovering traditional organic cultivation methods

Itinerary Details

Day 1: Hanoi Arrival

Arrive in Hanoi where you are met by your guide at Noi Bai Airport and transferred privately to your hotel. After check in, enjoy free time to relax or begin exploring the city at your own pace. You may choose to stroll nearby streets, sample local cuisine, or simply unwind after your journey.

Overnight in Le Jardin Hotel & Spa (4 Star) or similar.

Day 2: Heritage Highlights (B/ L/ D)

Begin your morning city tour with visits to the Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum, viewing the exterior of the Presidential Palace, the iconic One Pillar Pagoda, and the historic Temple of Literature, Vietnam's first university. In the afternoon, join a hands on cooking class where you learn to prepare traditional Vietnamese dishes before enjoying the meal you have created for dinner at a local restaurant.

Overnight in Le Jardin Hotel & Spa (4 Star) or similar.

Day 3: Yen Tu Spiritual Legacy (B/ L)

After breakfast, depart for Yen Tu Mountain, regarded as the cradle of Vietnamese Buddhism. Take a scenic cable car ride up the forested slopes to visit the Truc Lam Yen Tu Zen Monastery and continue on to Dong Pagoda, set high above the clouds. Enjoy sweeping mountain views and a peaceful spiritual atmosphere as you explore. Later, settle in for an overnight stay at Legacy Yen Tu – MGallery by Sofitel.

Overnight in Legacy Yen Tu – MGallery by Sofitel (5 Star) or similar.

Day 4: Halong Bay (B/ L/ D)

Depart Yen Tu and journey to Halong Bay, a UNESCO World Heritage site famous for its dramatic limestone karsts and emerald waters. Upon arrival, board a luxury cruise and begin your exploration of the bay. Spend the day discovering hidden caves, enjoying optional kayaking adventures, or simply relaxing on the deck while taking in the spectacular seascape. The evening is spent dining onboard and cruising through this iconic landscape.

Overnight in Mon Cheri Cruise (5 Star) or similar.

Day 5: Hue (B)

Start your day with an early morning Tai Chi session on the deck, followed by brunch while cruising through Halong Bay. Disembark late morning and transfer back to Hanoi for your flight to Hue. Upon arrival in Hue, enjoy a private transfer to your hotel where you can relax and refresh after the journey. Spend the remainder of the day at leisure, exploring your surroundings or enjoying the hotel's amenities.

Overnight in Eldora Hotel (4 Star) or similar.

Day 6: Imperial City Tour (B/ L)

After breakfast, embark on a full-day tour of Hue, the former imperial capital of Vietnam. Visit the magnificent Imperial Citadel, then take a scenic boat ride along the Perfume River to Thien Mu Pagoda. Continue to explore the elaborate royal tombs of Khai Dinh and Tu Duc, reflecting the grandeur of the Nguyen Dynasty. Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant before returning to your hotel.

Validity Period: Jan 2026 to Dec 2026

Overnight in The Saga Hotel Hoian (4 Star) or similar.

Day 7: Hoi An via Hai Van pass (B/ L)

Depart Hue in the morning and drive along the scenic Hai Van Pass, known for its breathtaking coastal views. Stop briefly at Lang Co Beach for photos and relaxation before continuing to Hoi An. Upon arrival, explore the UNESCO listed Ancient Town, visiting the iconic Japanese Bridge, Tan Ky Old House, and Phuc Kien Assembly Hall. Stroll through the charming streets and admire the well-preserved architecture before returning to your hotel.

Overnight in Eldora Hotel (4 Star) or similar.

Day 8: Hoi An to Nha Trang (B/ L)

Enjoy a leisurely morning in Hoi An, with optional cycling to the nearby Tra Que Vegetable Village or free time to explore the town. In the afternoon, transfer to Danang Airport for your flight to Nha Trang. Upon arrival, a private transfer will take you to your seaside resort where you can relax by the beach or pool.

Overnight in Citadines Bayfront Nha Trang (5 Star) or similar.

Day 9: Island Exploration (B/ L)

Embark on a boat trip to explore the nearby islands of Nha Trang. Visit the Tri Nguyen Aquarium and enjoy swimming or snorkeling in the clear waters around Hon Mun Island. Lunch is served at a local beach restaurant, offering fresh seafood and local specialties. Return to your hotel in the afternoon and enjoy leisure time to relax by the beach or explore the town.

Overnight in Citadines Bayfront Nha Trang (5 Star) or similar.

Day 10: City Highlights Tour (B/ D)

Take a morning flight to Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam's bustling southern metropolis. In the afternoon, embark on a sightseeing tour, visiting the iconic Notre Dame Cathedral, the historic Central Post Office, and the Reunification Palace. Explore the lively Ben Thanh Market, where you can shop for souvenirs and sample local delicacies. Return to your hotel in Ho Chi Minh City for an overnight stay.

Overnight in Paradise Saigon Boutique Hotel & Spa (4 Star) or similar.

Day 11: Ho Chi Minh City Departure (B)

After breakfast at your hotel, enjoy free time until your private transfer to Tan Son Nhat International Airport for your departure flight. Use this final opportunity to relax, take last-minute photos, or pick up souvenirs before bidding farewell to Vietnam.
