Continue to the cool highlands of Brastagi, exploring volcanic vistas, bustling fruit markets, and the serene Shwedagon-inspired pagoda. Travel on to Samosir Island in the middle of Lake Toba, the world's largest volcanic lake, pausing at cascading waterfalls, traditional Batak villages, and sweeping viewpoints. Discover ancient stone relics, royal tombs, and weaving traditions before ending with a farewell dinner by the lake. A perfect blend of nature, culture, and unforgettable scenery.

Itinerary Details

Day 1: Medan to Bukit Lawang

Begin your North Sumatra journey as you arrive at Medan International Airport, where you'll be greeted and transferred to the rainforest haven of Bukit Lawang. The scenic drive takes you past rubber and oil-palm plantations, gradually giving way to lush jungle landscapes that set the tone for the adventure ahead. On arrival, settle into your nature-framed accommodation and unwind to the tranquil sounds of the forest.

Overnight in Bukit Lawang Cottage (or similar)

Day 2: Jungle Trekking Adventure (B)

Wake up to the sounds of the jungle and prepare for an exhilarating trek into the heart of Leuser National Park. After breakfast, embark on a guided hike through dense rainforest, teeming with vibrant flora and fauna. As you walk beneath towering trees, keep your eyes peeled for the elusive orangutans, who swing effortlessly from branch to branch. Along the way, you may also encounter other fascinating wildlife such as Thomas Leaf monkeys, playful Macaques, Gibbon and Black Gibbons. The three-hour trek immerses you in the unspoiled beauty of this UNESCO-recognized ecosystem. Afterward, return to your hotel to relax, or take some time to explore the nearby village at your leisure.

Overnight in Bukit Lawang Cottage (or similar)

Day 3: Bukit Lawang to Brastagi (B/ L)

Today, journey to the cool highlands of Brastagi, a region known for its stunning volcanic landscapes and refreshing mountain air. Along the way, you'll pass through charming villages like Namu Ukur and Rumah Galuh, catching glimpses of local life. The road winds through verdant hills, offering awe-inspiring views of the active Sinabung Volcano as it dominates the horizon. Upon arrival in Brastagi, visit Lhumbini Park, home to an impressive replica of Myanmar's Shwedagon Pagoda. Explore the bustling fruit market, where vibrant tropical produce bursts with color, and take in panoramic views of the region from Gundaling Hill.

Overnight in Sinabung Hill Hotel (or similar)

Day 4: Brastagi to Samosir Island (B/ L)

After breakfast, depart for the iconic Samosir Island, nestled in the middle of the vast Lake Toba, the largest volcanic lake in the world. En route, visit the traditional Batak Karo village of Dokan, where the unique culture and customs of this indigenous community are preserved in their daily lives. Continue your journey to the spectacular Sipisopiso Waterfall, where the 90-meter-high cascade tumbles into the lake below, offering breathtaking views of Lake Toba from its northern edge. The drive also takes you to Tele, a lookout point providing sweeping vistas over the lake's western shores, before arriving at Efrata Waterfall, a tranquil and scenic stop. Finally, visit the village of Lumban Suhi-suhi, where the women of the village continue the centuries-old craft of weaving traditional Tobanese textiles. By mid-afternoon, you'll arrive at your accommodation on Samosir Island.

Overnight in Tabo Cottage (or similar)

Day 5: Discover the Mysteries of Samosir Island (B/ L/ D)

Today, explore the rich cultural heritage and natural beauty of Samosir Island. Your journey begins at Ambarita Village, where you will encounter the ancient stone chairs and tables used for tribal gatherings and executions by the island's former chieftains. Next, visit Aek Natonang, a serene lake located at the island's highest point, offering picturesque views of the surrounding countryside. In Tomok Village, discover the fascinating history of the Sidabutar Kings as you explore the ancient stone sarcophagi and learn about the island's spiritual traditions. After a day filled with culture and history, enjoy some free time at your hotel before gathering for a special farewell dinner, celebrating the end of your journey in North Sumatra.

Overnight in Tabo Cottage (or similar)

Day 6: Samosir Island Departure (B)

After breakfast, take a scenic ferry ride back across Lake Toba, soaking in the final views of this remarkable volcanic landscape. Transfer to the airport for your onward flight, carrying with you the memories of misty highlands, cascading waterfalls, cultural traditions, and the warmth of Sumatra's people. This journey may end, but the spirit of North Sumatra will remain with you long after you return home.

1. Booking & Confirmation

2. Payment Conditions

Full payment is required before guest arrival:

- Vietnam, Cambodia, Laos, Myanmar, Thailand, Indonesia: **30 days prior**
- Japan, South Korea, Singapore, Malaysia, Philippines: **35 days prior**

Payments must be made to the bank account stated on the invoice. All bank charges are borne by the payer. Late payments may result in price increases or cancellation of services. Overdue balances of more than 30 days are subject to 4% annual interest.

3. Deposits & Tickets
